AMENDATORY ENDORSEMENT – SWIMMING FACILITIES

This endorsement modifies insurance provided under the following:

- A.** The coverage under this policy does not apply to any actual or alleged injury, loss, damage, claim, cost, expense, fine, penalty, or other sum either directly or indirectly arising out of, relating to, contributed to, or caused by any diving board, diving activity, water slide, any type of swing, or swinging activity.
- B.** The coverage under this policy does not apply to any actual or alleged injury, loss, damage, claim, cost, expense, fine, penalty, or other sum either directly or indirectly arising out of, relating to, contributed to, or caused by the ownership, operation, maintenance, existence or use of any swimming pool, unless the following conditions exist:
1. A Red Cross certified or similarly approved certified lifeguard is on duty at all times during activities, or SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK – NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY signs are posted and clearly visible.
 2. The swimming pool must be completely enclosed by fencing and equipped with a self-closing, self-locking gate.
 3. The fencing must be:
 - (a) Six (6) feet in height or greater; or
 - (b) The height required by local law or ordinance if such local law or ordinance requires a fence four (4) feet in height or greater.
 4. The water depth markings are clearly visible on the pool sides; and
 5. The swimming pool must be equipped with suction safety devices as required by United States Code Annotated, Title 15, Commerce and Trade, Chapter 106, Pool and Spa Safety, Subchapter 8003, Federal Swimming Pool and Spa Drain Cover Standard.
 6. The swimming pool area must have:
 - (a) At least one (1) lifesaving ring and
 - (b) One (1) shepherd's hook long enough to enable a non-swimmer to pull a person from the center of the pool to the edge of the pool
 in proper working condition.
- C.** The coverage under this policy does not apply to any actual or alleged injury, loss, damage, claim, cost, expense, fine, penalty, or other sum either directly or indirectly arising out of, relating to, contributed to, or caused by the ownership, operation, maintenance, existence or use of any swimming area or swimming facility other than a pool, unless;
1. A Red Cross certified or similarly approved certified lifeguard is on duty at all times during swimming activities; and
 2. The swimming area is clearly marked by floating ropes and buoys; and
 3. Safety equipment (including, but not limited to, life preservers, lifesaving rings, ropes, shepherd's hook, etc.) is present and in proper working condition; and
 4. "NO SWIMMING ALLOWED WHEN LIFEGUARD NOT ON DUTY" signs are posted and clearly visible.

All other terms and conditions of this policy remain unchanged.
